Dear CWSA community,

As you heard, the Elementary Teachers' Federation of Ontario (ETFO) has provided notice that, if no contract agreement is reached, ETFO members will conduct a one day strike – full withdrawal of services on Monday, January 20, 2020. This will affect TDSB elementary schools.

As recommended in the correspondence sent directly from the TDSB on Wednesday, January 15 families are strongly encouraged to make alternate arrangements for their children. *Please do not send any students to Claude Watson School for the Arts on January 20th*.

School will resume on Tuesday, January 21st and all students are expected to attend.

We regret this disruption and understand your disappointment; however, we appreciate your continued understanding and patience during this time. We remain hopeful that an agreement with ETFO can be achieved in the very near future to minimize any further impact on our students.
